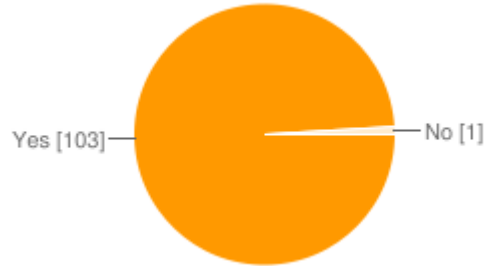

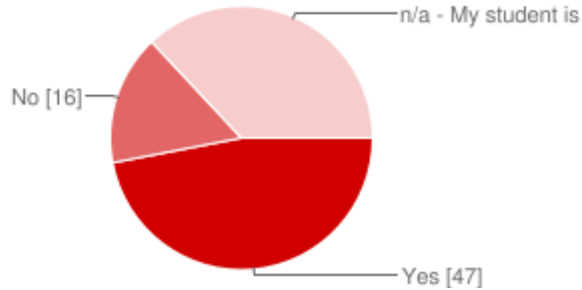

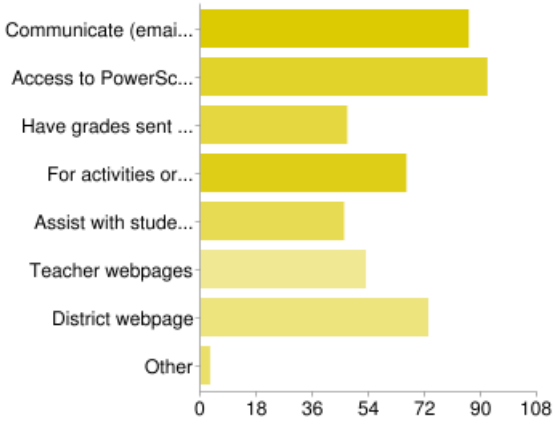

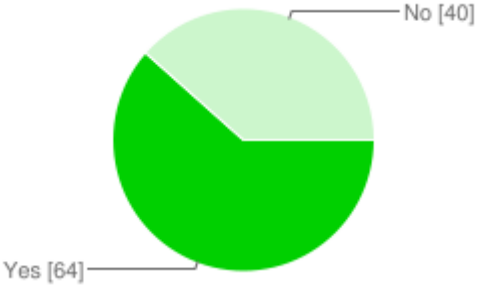

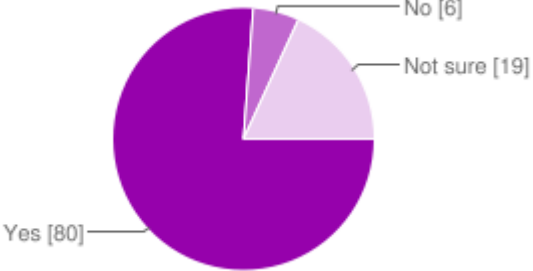

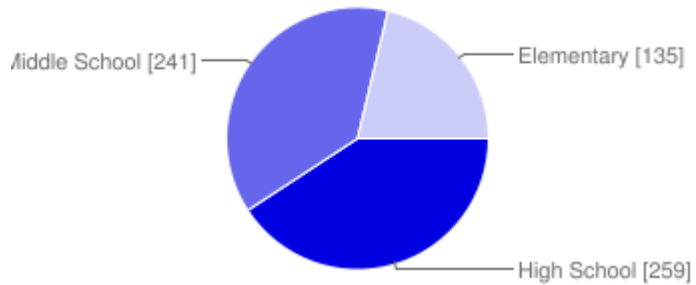

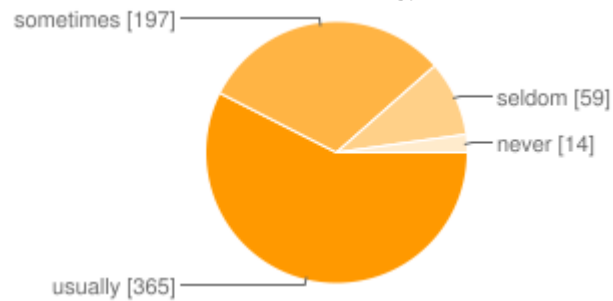

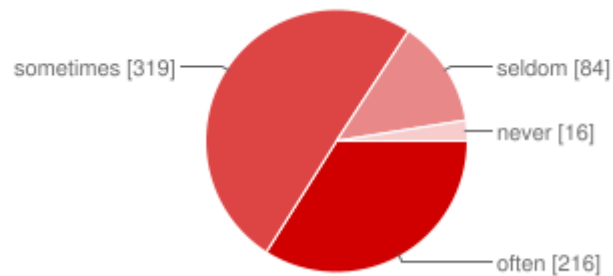

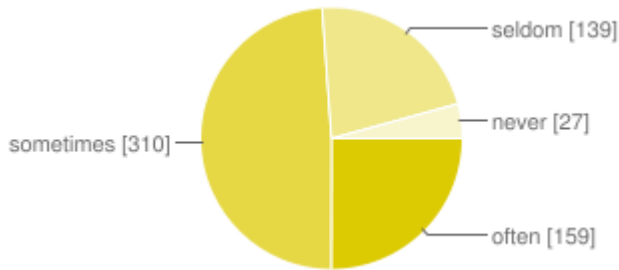

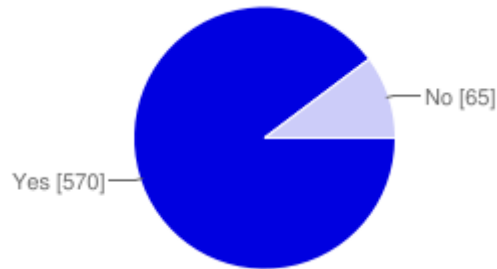

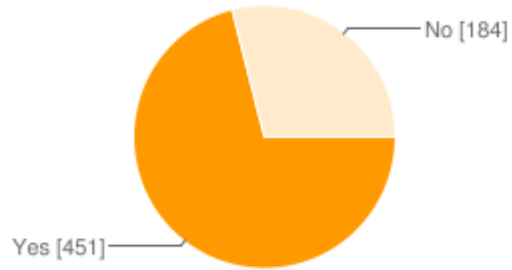

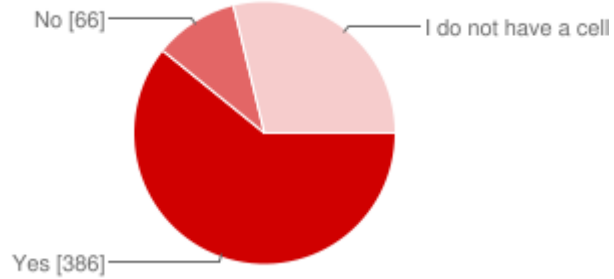

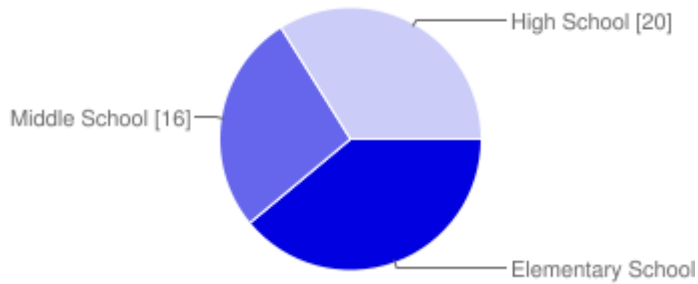
What technology would you prefer to have in your classrooms for student use?

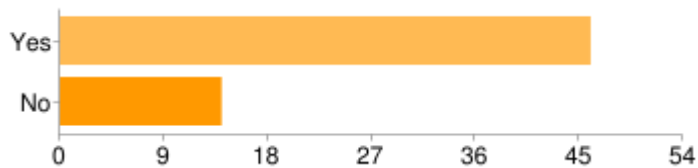

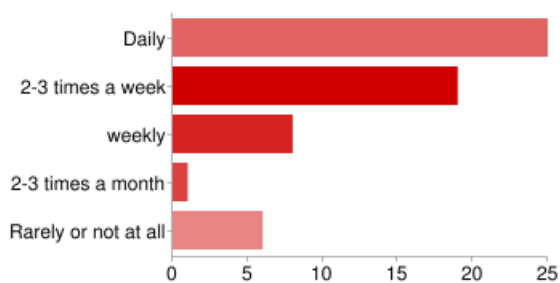

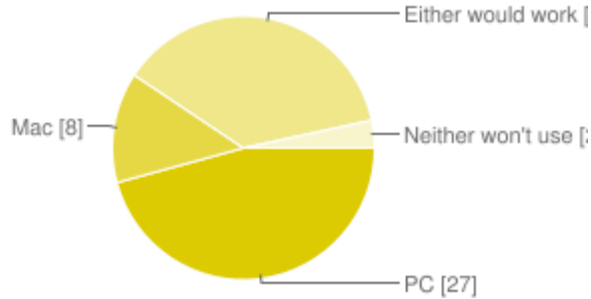

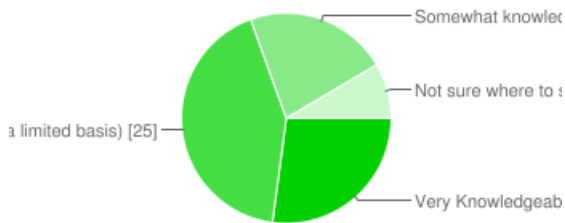

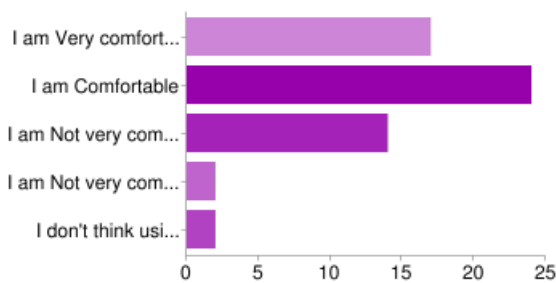

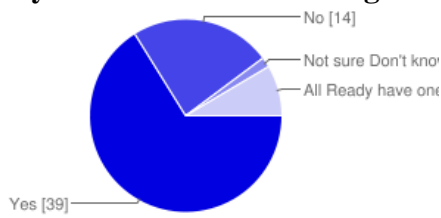

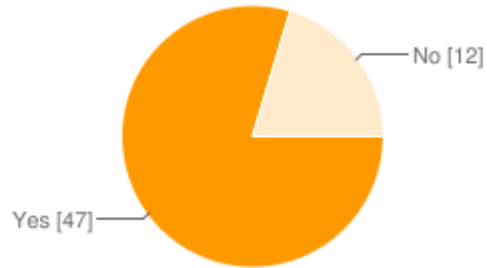

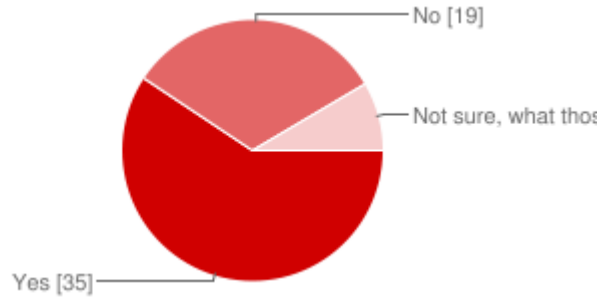

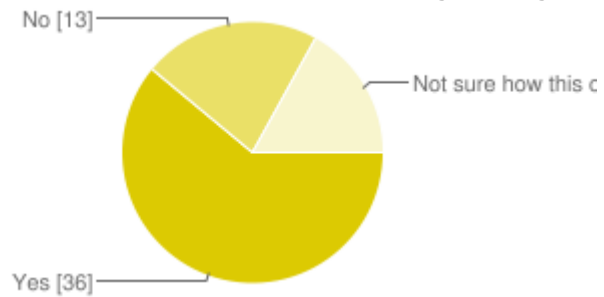

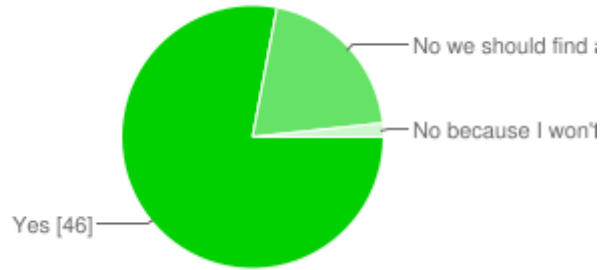

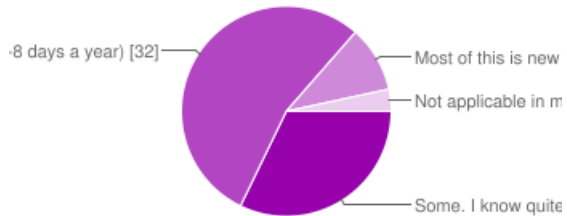

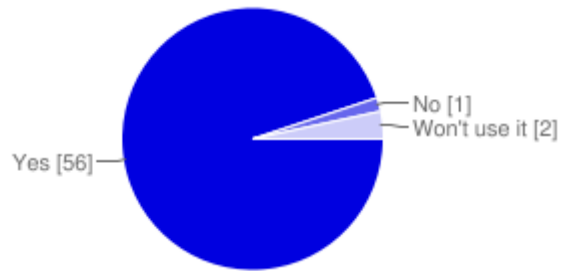

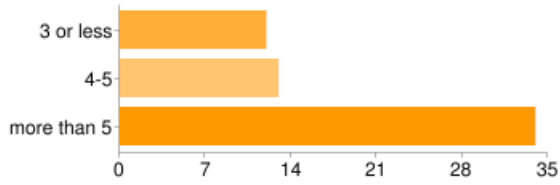

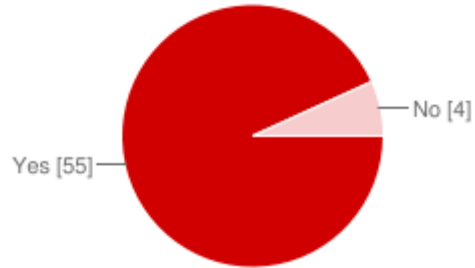

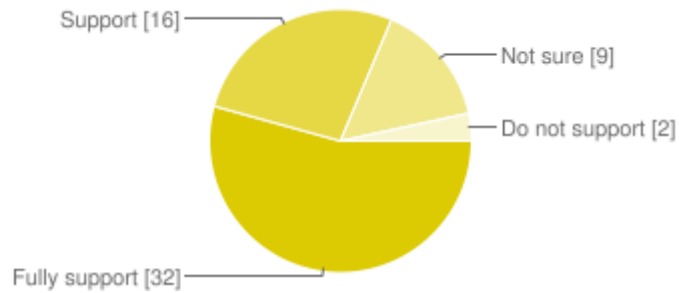

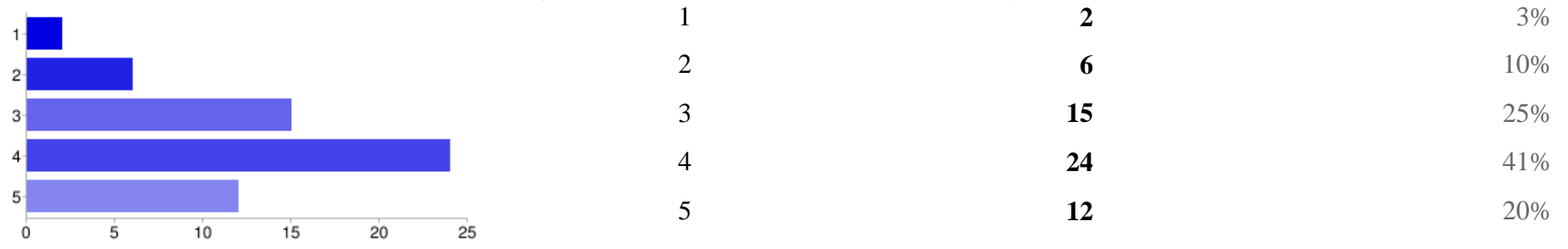
If we had a 1 to 1 initiative for students what device do you feel would be most useful to the students in your classroom? - Laptop



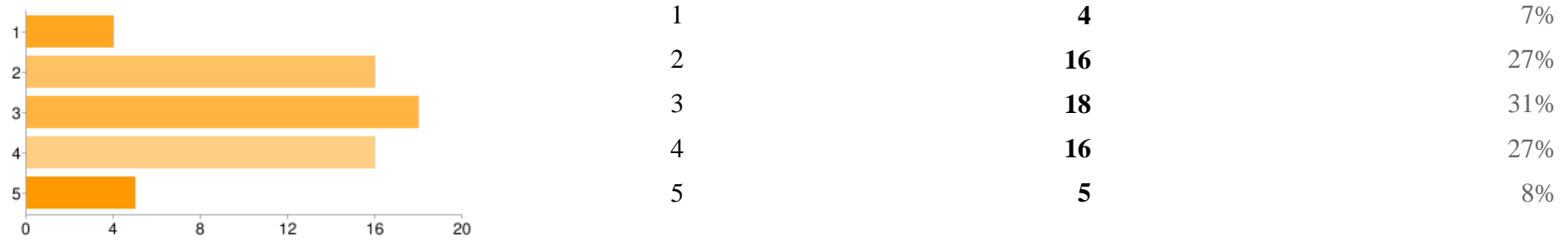
If we had a 1 to 1 initiative for students what device do you feel would be most useful to the students in your classroom? - iPad



If we had a 1 to 1 initiative for students what device do you feel would be most useful to the students in your classroom? - iPod



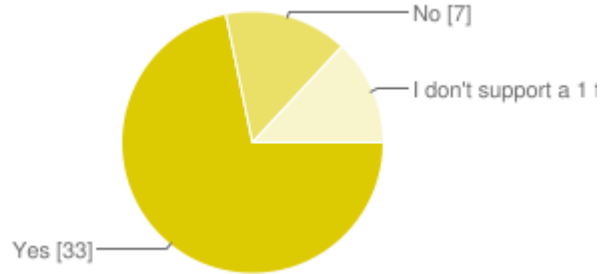

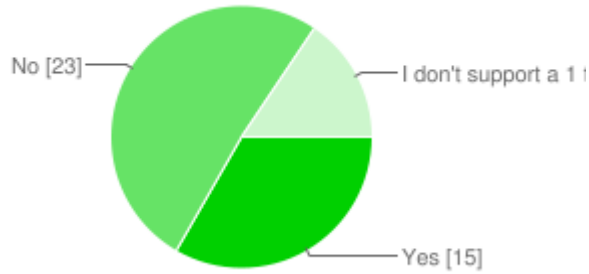

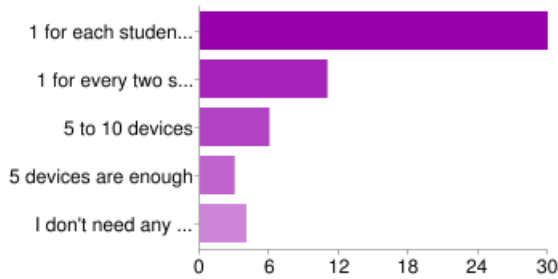

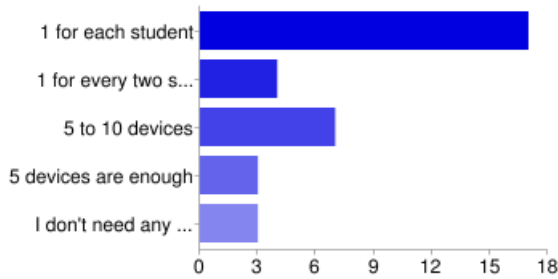
